Delivery Process	1. Framing: Define objectives, scope, and actor taxonomy 2. Desk Review: Build stakeholder list and hypotheses 3. Primary Data: Conduct KIIs, workshops, or surveys 4. Analysis: Apply Power-Interest Matrices, PEA, SNA, and GESI/conflict lenses 5. Synthesis: Develop engagement plans, roadmaps, and actions 6. Validation: Present findings in workshops and finalize outputs
